<input type="checkbox"/> Member Excellence in Education Award: This award recognizes Laboratory professional members who are actively involved in a medical laboratory education program and demonstrating outstanding performance in teaching through work in the classroom or clinic, or through the development of effective teaching methods and instructional materials.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Examples of outstanding performance in teaching through work in the classroom/clinic or through development of effective teaching methods and/or instructional materials. • Examples of whether personal and professional development of the student is a high priority of the nominee. • Demonstrated professionalism and service as a role model and mentor to his/her students and peers.

4. Awards and/or formal recognition in the field of laboratory medicine.
