### Eligibility Requirements

To be eligible for an Honor Award, you must:

- be a student member of ASCP
- have a minimum GPA of 3.3 on a 4.0 scale
- demonstrate leadership and community service activity participation

and **one** of the following:

- be in your final clinical year in an accredited MLS/MT, MLT, PA, CT, or HTL program
- be completing a clinical internship for an accredited MLS/MT or CT program
- be enrolled in an accredited hospital based MLS/MT program
- be enrolled in an accredited PBT or HT program
