Demonstrate Your Performance In Practice.

Document your interpersonal and communication skills, professionalism, ethics, and effectiveness in systems-based practice.

Document your lab's participation and your individual participation in interlaboratory improvement and QA programs.

Document the accreditation status of your lab (where applicable).

Provide 4 references:

- ABP-certified pathologist
- Credentials committee of the primary health facility where you practice
- Board-certified physician in another specialty
- Technologist or pathologist's assistant

Participate in at least one laboratory improvement and quality assurance activity or program per year (in each 2 year period).

Submit documentation electronically to the ABP.

Every 4 Years

and at the time of application for the MOC examination.

Every 2 Years

At the time of application for the MOC examination.
