- Develop a process by which ASCP representatives adequately represent ASCP policies
- Develop a process by which information gained from representatives is routinely fed to the appropriate commissions and committees.

- Three-year terms, renewable twice
- Two Members-at-Large should be pathologists

- One year term, renewable up to three times
