- Plan, review, and evaluate educational programs to ensure cost-effectiveness and value to the membership
- Identify & recruit respected program directors/faculty
- Solicit and oversee timely submission of program proposals
- Review, revise, and approve proposals
- Make recommendations to support ASCP educational strategies
- Review participant evaluations and make recommendations to repeat, revise, or discontinue programs
- Maintain compliance with accrediting, regulatory, and statutory requirements to offer education

- Three-year terms, renewable twice

1 Resident

- One-year term, renewable three times
