Established in 2007, this new award serves to recognize those distinguished members who have made significant contributions to the field of pathology and laboratory medicine and to the ASCP. Eligibility is based on years of ASCP membership, significant career accomplishments, and contributions to the Society and to the profession.

Each individual awarded the Master distinction will be able to use the credentials “MASCP” after his/her name. This credential would replace the distinction FASCP and appear ahead of any Board of Registry certification, such as MASCP, MT(ASCP).
